These then are the names by which God has revealed Himself and when we say “Hallowed be Your name”, we remind ourselves and the Father of the Covenant Names and what they mean to us.

Notice: There is not one hint of condemnation, judgement or reproach in God’s revelation of His character toward you.

This is how to come into the presence of God and share fellowship and communion with Him.

You have a right to expect God to be all these things to you, and He has a right to expect you to trust Him as your Heavenly Father. You have entered an eternal covenant with the Eternal God.
